Good for stays through Dec. 30, the hotel's [Cut the Bill at the Bull](#) promotion offers guests a choice of \$5 parking (reg. \$30 a night), continental breakfast, a cocktail (reg. \$10), dry cleaning or clothes pressing service. Room rates start at \$159 per night. Be sure to book directly through the hotel and mention the promo code BILL when you make your reservation.

It's not going to save you a bundle (you can only get one discounted amenity per stay), but it's a promo that's worth knowing about – especially if you'll have a car with you. Choosing the car amenity looks like it will result in the biggest overall savings.
